Our members provide housing and services across the continuum from homelessness, to rental housing, to homeownership.

As partners in the Housing Alliance, we support a comprehensive 2017 agenda for housing, including:

- **Increase Supply of Affordable Rental Housing**
  - Increase Document Recording Fee by \$20 (HB 3357)
  - Extend and increase Oregon Affordable Housing Tax Credit (HB 2852)
  - Authorize \$100 million in LIFT bond funding (SB 5505)
  - Preserve existing affordable housing
  - Create land acquisition program (HB 2912)
  - Agricultural workforce housing – operations tax credit (SB 1)
- **Increase Tenant Protections** – create just cause eviction standard and lift ban on rent stabilization (HB 2004)
- **Create Homeownership Opportunity**
  - Down payment assistance program (HB 3192)
  - Repairs for low-income homeowners (HB 2961)
  - Foreclosure counseling
  - Revolving loan fund for new homes (HB 2570)
  - Set aside \$20 million of LIFT bonds for homeownership
- **Reform the Mortgage Interest Deduction** – generate new revenue for housing investment. While our bill HB 2006 is not moving this session, we will continue to spotlight the need for reform of Oregon's largest housing subsidy.
